
CONVERSATIONS WITH GOD

Pour our His Spirit in a powerful way for the purpose of impacting our community:


Ephesians 3:10:


This is an invitation to us as a church family to a deeper place of prayer



Give us today the food we need, and forgive us our


sins, as we have forgiven those who sin against us.
